



Cannabidiol (CBD): a naturally occurring plant compound found in the flower of cannabis, a plant with a rich history as a medicine going back thousands of years.

Sebum: a light yellow, oily substance that is secreted by the sebaceous glands that help keep the skin and hair moisturized. Sebum is made up of triglycerides, free fatty acids, wax esters, squalene, cholesterol esters, and cholesterol.

TRPV-1: TRPV1 receptor cells are involved in thermoregulation, making them a possible target for the modulation of energy expenditure via heat production, either via direct thermogenesis or as a compensatory mechanism in response to TRPV1 induced heat-loss. Further, it is becoming apparent that TRPV1 may be involved in the regulation of appetite via the modulation of appetite hormones and/or by acting on gastrointestinal vagal afferents.

5-HT1A: a subtype of serotonin receptor located in presynaptic and postsynaptic regions. Activation of this receptor involves the mechanism of action of anxiolytic, antidepressant and antipsychotic medications.

When we talk about the absorption of CBD, we're referring to its transfer from the site of administration to the bloodstream, where it can then be transported throughout the body to interact with or influence cannabinoid receptors CB1 and CB2, and non-cannabinoid receptors like serotonin receptor 5-HT1A and vanilloid receptor TRPV-1.

Human skin in general has low permeability, which means it blocks most substances from entering. However, high-quality CBD is known to be permeable, absorbing directly into the site. Research has also found when CBD is absorbed into the skin it tends to inhibit lipid synthesis, limiting the amount of sebum and preventing the overproduction of oils that clog pores.

Although the research is only beginning, CBD is a fantastic way to tackle some of the more common skin problems, including:
